

Steps to report cyber bullying

How to report cyber bullying

You can report cyberbullying through the eSafety Commissioner. But, before you do, follow the steps below.

STEP 1

Report the abuse to the social media platform.

Social media safety centres provide advice to help you deal with a range of online safety issues, including cyber bullying.

STEP 2

Collect the evidence of abuse.

The eSafety Commissioner can help you have serious cyberbullying material removed from social media sites. But you'll need to provide them with some information before they can act.

We know it can be overwhelming and sometimes intrusive for you, however actual examples of the cyber bullying material needs to be sent through for it to be reported. You can send URLs or web addresses, screenshots, scanned printouts of any messages or photos and videos (up to 80MB).

STEP 3

- What is happening?
- Where's it happening?
- About you.
